SUMMER SCHOOL

Summer School will begin on Monday 7th August, 2023 for students promoted to JSS 1-3 and SSS 1 to SSS 2. This year's summer is summer with a difference. It has come with a lot of packages- coding, photography and editing, music school, excursion and many more.

New intakes into JSS one are all expected in the summer school.

SSS 3 SUMMER SCHOOL (GCE COACHING AND CODING)

GCE coaching fee has been included in the bill sent to parents in June, 2023. In addition to the GCE coaching, SSS 3 students are to register and pay for any of the packages as slated below:

i. Coding – #20,000 ii. Photography and Editing or Music School -- #15,000

NOTE: This addition to GCE coaching is compulsory for all SSS 3 students.

EXTERNAL WAEC REGISTRATION FOR SSS TWO STUDENTS

SSS two students are not allowed to register for WAEC examination; except the GCE which the school allows and is responsible for while in SSS 2. Erring students will be expelled.

COLLEGE GYMNASIUM

The college's gymnasium is available for both students and parents' use. The fee is #5,000 per term for students and #10,000 per month for parents.

SSS ONE UNIFORMS

It is mandatory for SSS 1 students to buy new uniforms having worn the ones issued to them in JSS 1 for three years.

SSS 3 STUDENTS 2023/2024

All SSS 3 students are expected to pay the fees for the whole session now. To enable parents prepare for payments, we have sent SSS 3 bills in June 2023. Please try and comply with the terms of payment.

All SSS3 students are expected to come to the hostels next session.

PAYMENT OF FEES

We are still operating the five percent reduction in the tuition fees of multiple biological children. All Fees must be paid before resumption in September. Defaulters will not be allowed to resume. Boarders should bring their tellers to resume.

INFORMATION TO PARENTS OF BOARDERS**

1. PROVISIONS

Boarders are now allowed to bring provision items to hostel as listed and regulated below.

1. Milk – 3 rolls
2. Beverage – 3 rolls
3. Cereal (any type) – 3 rolls
4. Sugar – 1 packet
- 5 Biscuit – 4 dozens of biscuit or 2 packets of cabin biscuit
6. Nutri C – 1 Pack

Students are expected to bring the provisions fully secured in a strong small traveling bag with secured lock.

Please note that the following items are still banned from the boarding house:

1. Garri
2. Bottle/Pet drinks
3. Groundnut in breakable bottles

Any other item in excess of what is on the above list will be seized at the point of entry.

The boarders are expected to adhere strictly to the list above.

2. USE OF CUTLERY

Boarding house students should bring their cutlery set to school from next term- unbreakable plates, cups, spoons and forks. (breakable plates, breakable cups and knives not allowed)

3. HAIRDO:

Boys should bring personal clippers to school.

Girls weaving their hair should bring weaving comb and money for weaving.

4. KEEPING MONEY:

Boarders should not hold money. Pocket money, barbing money, hair weaving money and voucher money should be deposited in the college's administrative office on arrival. We always render adequate account of how the money is spent.

5. VISITING DAY:

Parents should bring limited food and only two bottles of soft drinks for a child.

We have sent this information to parents again and again. Please try and comply.

Our reasons:

After every visiting day, we have cases of diarrhoea, vomiting and purging by boarders. These resulted from consumption of all sorts of foods and drinks.
